5% overall participation rate



93% believe it is important to be involved in the political process


86% believe the political process can impact the success of S&P Global


HOW ARE POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEES FUNDED?

- Active Support The candidate's support for the company, its success and profitability, and the success, prosperity and well-being of its employees
- Representation Whether the candidate represents a state or district that includes company facilities and employees
- Committee Involvement Whether the candidate serves in a leadership position, or on a committee or subcommittee of jurisdiction or other importance
- Values and Morals Whether the candidate shares and upholds the company's values and those of its employees
- Partisan Standing Political realities, including but not limited to partisan control of one or both chambers of Congress

Federal law requires us to use best efforts to collect and report the name, address, occupation and employer of each individual whose aggregate contributions exceed \$200 in a calendar year.
